

Cut and paste the steps to creating a human-shaped rock engraving in the correct order:

The pecked holes were then rubbed until they all joined together in a groove.

When finished the groove would have been a few centimetres deep.

Then the outline of the shadow was drawn onto the rock with charcoal or ochre.
